To the Honorable Justices of the Supreme Court of Mississippi
Through the Office of the Clerk

I am writing as a member of Carly's Warriors, an international group of supporters, family members, and individuals closely following the case of Ms. Carly Gregg. Although I am writing from Poland, I feel a strong responsibility to speak on behalf of fairness, justice, and the importance of fully understanding the circumstances surrounding her conviction.

The tragic loss of Ms. Gregg's mother has left a profound impact on everyone connected to this case. At the same time, it is important to acknowledge that their relationship has been consistently described as loving, close, and supportive. There is no clear indication of long-term conflict or hostility that would typically precede such a heartbreaking event.

What stands out most is the serious decline in Ms. Gregg's mental health prior to the incident. Reports from those close to her indicate that she was experiencing visible and worsening psychological distress. Despite these warning signs, it appears that she did not receive the level of psychiatric care, evaluation, or medical support that her condition required.

This raises significant concerns:

That her mental health crisis may not have been adequately addressed before the incident.

That her psychological state may not have been fully understood or properly evaluated during the legal proceedings.

That the absence of appropriate treatment may have played a crucial role in her actions at the time.

Additionally, there are concerns regarding possible systemic shortcomings, including delayed access to care and insufficient intervention despite clear warning signs.

It is also deeply meaningful that members of Ms. Gregg's family—those most directly affected by this tragedy—continue to stand by her. Their support suggests that this incident does not reflect her true character, but rather a moment of severe psychological crisis.

With full respect for this Court, I kindly ask that the following be considered:

An independent and comprehensive review of Ms. Gregg's case, including her medical and psychiatric history prior to the incident.

A renewed evaluation of her mental state at the time of the offense by qualified mental health professionals.

Consideration of whether the lack of adequate treatment should be recognized as a significant mitigating factor.

A careful assessment of whether the current judgment fully aligns with the principles of justice, proportionality, and humane treatment in cases involving mental health crises.

My intention is not to diminish the seriousness of this tragedy, but to respectfully ask that all relevant factors—especially those related to mental health—are fully and fairly considered.
